- a. Advising Success Network Updates Amy. Amy met with group 2, they were unsure what they are supposed to be doing and thought there was overlap with other groups' content. Message was sent to bring all groups together and meeting has been set. Third team will be starting in January instead of November. Open space within group 1, Amy Dennison is leaving. Last person on the waitlist, Nora Atkins, is leaving ISU. ASN groups will discuss the membership and what to do about replacing these 2 members.
- b. AAC Charge Review -Clint. AAC reviewed all comments/recommendations from AAC members and made changes to the AAC Charge.
- c. Advising Awards Committee Clint. Invitations sent out to all members.
- d. AAC Elections Clint. Nominations opened last year November 15-23. AAC elections took place December 1-3, results announced December 6. Still a reasonable timeline.

V. New Business

- a. Registration Date Assignment Adjustment Gina Turton. AAC-Tech has been working with technology solutions to address the slowness during registration. Registration guardians registered with AAC-Tech watching it was taking a very long time for the students. Final session is Monday 11/7 for the freshman. The issue is there are so many people on the servers at once. Goal is to lessen the number of users all at once. System does recover, but it takes a few minutes.
 - i. Potential Solution: Split up each group of students registering (for example, splitting up freshman, sophomores, and juniors (see sample schedule below). Split by credit hours. Registration would start at 8:30am to allow advisors to respond to email, etc. and then next registration time would be 8:45am, or later at 12:30pm. Discussion surrounding students missing both their 8:00am and 9:00am classes in order to register. Some

professors do allow students to register at the beginning of an 8:00am course – unsure if this will still stand for 8:30am registration time. Suggestions included registration starting at 12:30pm, night-time, or 3:00pm. There really is no ideal registration time, but the least impact and slowness is likely with the proposed schedule. Suggestion to allow sophomore students with less credit hours to register prior to sophomore students with higher credit hours during spring, since they would register after them during fall.
