 - a. Spring 2017 Advance Registration Dates Discussed specific dates for each class to begin registering. Maybe start Priority groups at 8 am and other groups at 7 am? No final decision was made on this.
 - i. Give departments/schools/UC tips on how to handle first-day traffic (as the first day each class registers has the highest number of students with registration issues). Jess will send a list of tips to the ISUADV listserv. We want to get this information out early so advisors can get their plans in place and notify students. Send out these tips at the same time as the Spring 2017 Advance Registration Dates.
 - ii. Financial Responsibility Agreement E-mail students a pre-registration reminder to fill this out before their enrollment appointments.
 - iii. Discussion on pushing registration back a week, beginning October 17th instead of October 10th. We will return to this discussion at the next meeting to make a decision. Academic calendars need the approval of the Senate, so any potential changes we would like to make will need to be approved by the Senate.
 - b. Winter Session There will be two separate enrollment appointments (one for Winter and one for Spring) so that Winter registration can close. Winter registration would begin the same time as Spring registration. Students on probation and new admits are not eligible to register for this session. There are only five classes being offered, and students can only take one. Release date for the courses is TBD.
 - c. AT is being asked to find an automated process to assign advisors as well as find a way to list anticipated major.
