2) some standard SIS and some special BI reports will be created in the new SIS system; please email Jess with the description of the types of reports you need so that LEAP Forward can assess and prioritize;

- Jess asked for advisors to email him with any concerns that LEAP Forward should be away of; he mentioned that the Academic Senate had been told anecdotally that "advisors" were "upset" about the prospect of a new system; members of the committee hadn't heard other advisors express that;
- There are still many processes and procedures that have to be completed before the new SIS system goes into place—such as related systems for housing, admissions, financial aid, etc.;
- Transfer course articulation system is not ready yet. So there will be a mixture of old and new system auditing occurring. If advisors have a question about an articulation, please contact Evaluations to double check.
- The new Course Finder
  - 1) will include course descriptions;
  - 2) students must pick a gen ed profile to navigate through it;
  - 3) but that Course Finder might "go away";
